One each; for a Junior, an Intermediate, a Senior

PURPOSE: The purpose of this award is to acknowledge and encourage 4-H youth throughout Kitsap Co. who have participated during the current session in a photo project through their Club. Award nominees and winners need not have won top awards during the Fair to be eligible.

NOMINATIONS: Club leader(s) and parents may consult club members (or not) and nominate one or more members who they feel have met the criteria for this award. Forms however, must be submitted through the Club Leader(s).

CRITERIA:

1. The nominee must be a junior, intermediate, or senior 4-H member enrolled in the photography project during the current Session in Kitsap County.
2. The nominee should have turned in their completed record book to their club leader by the cutoff date and it should have been juried. *(10 points possible)*
3. The nominee should have given a public presentation, illustrated talk, or demonstration at the Club level or the County level. *(10 points possible)*
4. The nominee should have been a 4-H photo exhibitor at the Kitsap County Fair during the current Session. *(20 points possible)*
5. The nominee should have participated in some community service; either with the club or separately. *(20 points possible)*
6. The nominating statement should also indicate some specifics about the 4-H member's personal growth this year with regard to areas like: leadership, learning, giving or contributions (not just money, but time and skills), photography, family. *(40 points possible)*
