

Plant List for Episode 1 of “The Kitsap Gardener” – Lawns

Ground Cover Plant List – plants shown in the video

Plants are listed in the order in which they were shown in the video:

Brass buttons – You’ll find this plant under the name *Cotula squalida* and its newer classification *Leptinella squalida*

Ajuga (both variegated and regular form) – many varieties

Sedum – many varieties

Irish Moss (*Sagina sabulata*) – the variety shown is Irish moss and sometimes called Scotch moss – Its botanical name is *Sagina sabulata*

Flowering Thyme – many varieties

Mahonia repens (Oregon Grape) – *repens* is the prostrate form

Kinnikinnick – *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*

Salal – *Gaultheria shallon*

Creeping Himalayan Blueberry – *Vaccinium maupinense* – and other varieties

Lingon Berries – *Vaccinium vitis*

Periwinkle Vine – *Vinca* – many varieties – leaves can be solid, variegated and yellow or white with dark green edges – colors vary by variety. Flower colors can be: white, pink, purple and light blue depending on the variety.

Creeping Jenny – *Lysimachia nummularia*

Sweet Woodruff - *Galium*

Speedwell (aka Veronica) – Many references call this plant *Veronica* but plant labels in most nurseries will say *Speedwell*. This is a large variety of plants with some growing quite tall. Make sure you have the ground cover variety. Most of the flowers are in the purple to magenta category, but you will also find ones that are pink and white.

Pachysandra – This plant will perform in shade or sun. Varieties are variegated or solid.

Bluestar creeper – *Pratia angulata* – this plant performs somewhat as an evergreen

Vinca – Larger form
